Mr. Charles Robert Adams, 80, beloved husband of Patsy Adams for 58 years, died Sunday, January 27, 2008 at Waccamaw Community Hospital. Mr. Adams was born in Charlotte, North Carolina, a son of the late Milton and Ethel Adams. He graduated from Berryhill High School, Class of 1945. He then started working for Ford Motor Co. in Charlotte. He was called into service in January 24, 1952 for the Korean Conflict. Upon his return from Korea, he started back at Ford and continued there for another 20 years. In 1966, he left Ford and started Adams Featherstone Ford in Lancaster, SC. In 1977 he moved to Surfside Beach and started the company, Weather Guard, operating it until 2004. Charles was a very successful business person and he never met a stranger. Charles received his 50 years of service pin for Master Mason on September 28, 2005 and continued serving until his death. His family, however, came first and always, and was his life. Mr. Adams is survived by his wife, Patsy Adams of Murrells Inlet; children, Chuck Adams Susan of Surfside Beach, Steve Adams Audrey of Murrells Inlet, Sharon Wheeling Greg of Charlotte, N.C., and Scott Adams Melissa of Murrell Inlet; sister, Francis A. Eaton of Fort Mill; brother, John E. Adams of Wake Forest, NC; 10 grandchildren, and four great-grandchildren, the last being Charles R. Adams IV, born on January 24, 2008. He was preceded in death by his sister, Patricia Adams Roush. Services will be held at 2 p.m. on Wednesday, January 30, 2008 at Surfside United Methodist Church. Visitation will be from 5 to 7 p.m. Tuesday, January 29, 2008 at Goldfinch Funeral Home, Beach Chapel.
