CONWAY.....Charles Samuel Chicola, age 81, died Thursday, October 21, 2004 at Conway Medical Center. Mr. Chicola was born in New Brighton Staten Island, NY, a son of the late Angelo and Carmella Fanciullo Chicola. He graduated from Curtis High School and attended New York State University. Mr. Chicola was a US Army Veteran of WWII having fought in the Battle of the Bulge while serving with the 35th Division, 654th Tank Destroyer Battalion. He was a Purple Heart Recipient and served in the New York State National Guard. Mr. Chicola was a member of the American Legion Watkins/Kellet Post #277 in Staten Island, NY. He retired as a Supervisor for the New York City Department of Parks and Recreation and Cultural Affairs after 25 years of service. Mr. Chicola was stationed at Central Park and City Hall Park in New York City. He was a former member of the Staten Island Ballroom Dancers for 15 years and enjoyed gardening. Mr. Chicola resided in Great Kills, Staten Island for 20 years before moving to Conway and predeceased by one son Robert Mark Chicola who passed away on 9/8/02, who was a survivor of 9-11; three brothers Nicholas Chicola, Samuel Chicola, Michael Chicola; two sisters Mary Sinibaldi and Eleanor Trifaro. Surviving are his wife of 54 years, Gloria Chicola of Conway; one daughter Linda Chicola Crocker and her husband Richard "Randy" of Myrtle Beach; two sons, Steven Chicola and Richard Chicola and his wife Suzanne all of Conway; two granddaughters, Lindy Chicola of Conway and Carmella Chicola Kelly of Staten Island, NY and one great-granddaughter Lexiss Kelly of Staten Island, NY.

Funeral services will be held 11:00 AM Monday from Goldfinch Funeral Home, Conway Chapel with Rev. John Renfro officiating. The family will receive friends from 6-8 PM Saturday and 2-4 PM and 6-8 PM Sunday at the funeral home.
