Charles Willis Stone age 77, died Thursday, January 1, 2015 at his residence. Born in Johnsonville, SC, he was a son of the late Hilburn and Blondell Stone. Mr. Stone was a U.S. Army National Guard veteran. He was owner of Industrial Contractor Inc and also former owner of Marlin Quay Marina. He was a past Master Mason, a member of the Shriners and served on the South Atlantic Marine Fishery Council.
