Cheryl Spence Holowacz, 68, passed away Friday, May 16, 2014 at home in Myrtle Beach, SC, after a nine month battle with cancer.

Born June 30, 1945 in Covington, KY, Cheryl was the daughter of the late William A. Spence and Dorothy Spence. She was a long time resident of the Columbia/Irmo area before moving to Myrtle Beach in 2001. 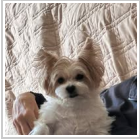
