Clara Margaret Hull Ward, age 88, of Myrtle Beach, passed away February 1, 2022 in Myrtle Beach, SC.

Clara attended the Shenandoah Conservatory of Music where she graduated in 1955 with a Bachelors of Music Education Degree majoring in piano and minoring in organ.
