



## Ed Grove

Mr. Clarence Edmund "Ed" Grove, age 84, passed away unexpectedly at his home on Wednesday, March 18, 2026.

Born February 14, 1942 in Birmingham, AL, he was the son of the late Joseph Augustus Grove, Jr. and the late Lucy Wright Grove. In addition to his wife of 58 years, Suzanne, and his parents, Ed was predeceased by his siblings Jack Grove, Margaret Ann Anglin, Nina Sparkman, and Sue Stone; and his brother-in-law, Frank Weber.

Ed was a veteran of the United States Army who served in Vietnam. He graduated from Auburn University with a degree in Forestry and in 1983 he formed his own company, Grove Construction Co., Inc. He was a master craftsman and contractor who took great pride in his work and possessed a work ethic beyond compare. Ed, along with others, was instrumental in the repair and restoration of the Conway City Clock on the corner of Third and Main, as well as many older homes in and around Conway. His expert craftsmanship was also evidenced in the restoration of antique furniture.

Ed cherished time spent with his family and grandkids on family vacations to Disney World and in his younger years he could be found on the water fishing and waterskiing. He was very proud of his two daughters and loved his wife Suzanne beyond words. He was a member of Trinity United Methodist

Church.

Survivors include his daughters, Anne Stewart and husband John and Emily Burkett and husband Derek; his grandchildren, Meghan Cornelison, Rebecca Cornelison, and Noah Cornelison; his sister Elaine Grove; his brother-in-law, Chuck Weber and wife Glenda; and many nieces, nephews, and other extended family and friends.
