Conway, SC.....Claudette Gilchrist (née Oliver) age 87 of Conway, South Carolina passed on August 18, 2020 surrounded by her family. Claudette was employed as a secretary in the English Department at the State University of Old Westbury where she retired in 1988. The years

following were filled with visits from her children, grandchildren, nieces and nephews along with spending time with friends and traveling. She volunteered at Conway Medical Center for over 20 years wanting to give back to her community.

Claudette was passionate about her family. She was blessed with 11 Grandchildren (Ryan, Ashley, Alexandra, Danielle, Jordan, Brent, Sean, Eric, Erin, Ryleigh and Rebecca), four Great Grandchildren (Zofia, Rowan, Raelynn and Barrett) and many nieces and nephews that she adored.

She loved the ocean and beach and enjoyed when the grandchildren would visit taking them to it. She loved to sing, had a wonderful sense of humor and an infectious laugh. She truly had a compassionate heart and she has left an indelible imprint on those that knew her. She will be greatly missed.
