Cleveland W. "Peanut" Wright, age 83, passed away Friday, November 18, 2016 at his residence.

Mr. Wright was born in Horry County, SC, a son of the late Mack and Golia Phipps Wright. In addition to his parents, Mr. Wright was also preceded in death by his two brothers, Paul and Clarence Wright.

He was a faithful member of Langston Baptist Church in Conway where he served as an usher. Mr. Wright retired from the US Marine Corps with 30 years of honorable service. After his military career, he was employed for Crenshaw Vending for 14 years.
