He will be inurned in Wheelersburg, OH at a later date.

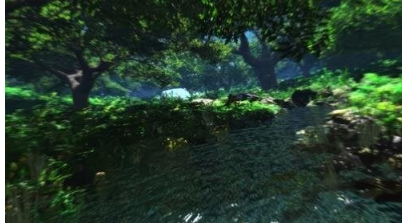

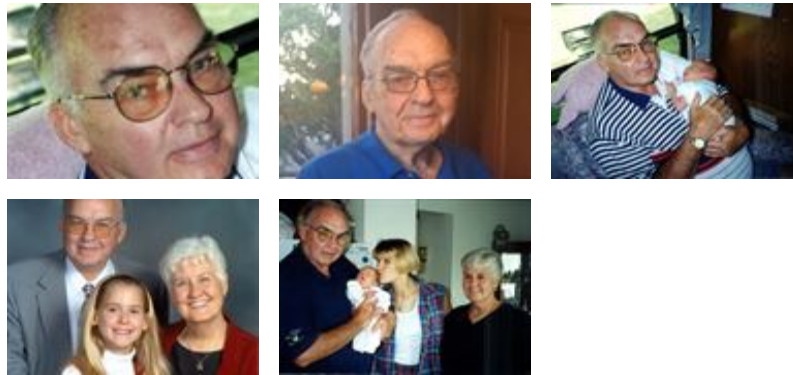
