Clifford Paul Riggs, 87, passed peacefully in the afternoon of August 29, 2019.

Mr. Riggs was born in Parkersburg, WV, son of the late Clifford and Grethel (McCullough) Riggs. He was a veteran of the United States Air Force and during his 30 years of service, held many high level assignments at the Pentagon, on Air Force One and with the Joint Chiefs of Staff.
