Dr. Clifton Durning Dr. Clifton M. Durning died Friday, September 8, 2006 at Waccamaw Medical Hospital. He was a graduate of St. Joseph's University and Jefferson Medical College. He was dedicated lifelong to learning and teaching. As a U.S. Navy medical officer during World War II he served on Guam and at the Bethesda Naval Hospital. He loved his country and was proud to be an American. After leaving the Navy, Dr. Durning was in practice as a family physician in Kennett Square, Pennsylvania for 42 years. Dr. Durning also served as Chief of Medicine and as Chief of Staff at Chester County Hospital in West Chester, Pennsylvania. He was an avid golfer and enjoyed traveling.
