Rev. Clyde Evans Hendrix, Sr., age 82, passed away Thursday, September 3, 2020.

Born July 22, 1938 in Bennettsville, SC, he was the son of the late Richard B. Hendrix and Carrie Jane Stognard Hendrix. Mr. Hendrix was a minor league baseball player.
