January 18, 1928 - August 17, 2024

Conway..... Clyde Jackson, age 96 peacefully passed away on Saturday, August 17, 2024.

Mr. Jackson was born in Dillon County, a son of the late William "Bill" Jackson and late Leah Powers Jackson Owens. He was predeceased by his loving and devoted wife of 46 years, Cora Prince Jackson; brothers, Roy Jackson and Walter Jackson; sisters, Mabel J. Perritt, Dorothy O. Hunter, Shirley O. Sheridan, Judy O. Fricke, and a special brother in law, Samuel "Bo" Prince. Mr. Jackson was a beloved son, brother, husband, father, grandfather, and great grandfather. At the time of his passing, he was the oldest living member of Jamestown Baptist Church and was a member of the Stan Boatwright Sunday School Class. Mr. Jackson proudly served in the US Army Air Corp, having served in the Philippines. Prior to retirement, he was employed by The Jerry Cox Company for 56 years, 54 of those as manager of the Bulk Fuel Plant, that bears his name.
