Constance B. "Chickie" MacDougall age 76, passed away on Tuesday December 1, 2020 in Myrtle Beach.

Connie was born in Brooklyn, NY to the late Salvatore and Sally VonFrolio. She moved to Saddlebrook NJ where she lived for 64 years until her final move to Myrtle Beach, SC. 
