December 5, 1928 - March 14, 2017

Mr. Julian Curtis Jordan, 88, husband of Margie M. Jordan, beloved husband and father, passed away at his home on Tuesday, March 14, 2017.

Born December 5, 1928 in Conway, Mr. Jordan was the son of the late Benjamin Franklin Jordan and the late Isla Thompkins Jordan. Mr. Jordan was a life-long farmer and a veteran of the United States Army who served during the Korean War. He was awarded the National Defense Service Medal, the Korean Service Medal with 1 Bronze Service Star, Combat Infantryman Badge 1st Award, and United Nations Service Medal. He was a man of integrity and quiet strength who possessed a servant's heart. He was respected and loved by those who knew him. Mr. Jordan was a lifetime member of Juniper Bay Baptist Church and served as a deacon and in many other capacities. Mr. Jordan was predeceased by his first wife of 27 years, Katie Richardson Jordan; one grandchild; his sisters, Elnita Wallace, Delia Owens, and Elease Capps; his brothers, Lucius Jordan, Billy Jordan, and Norman Jordan.

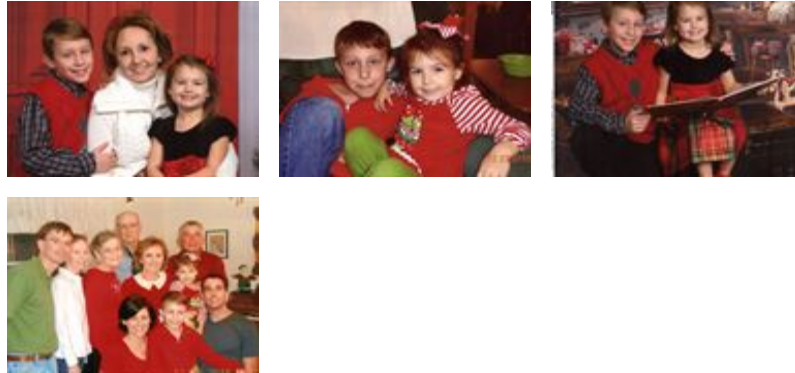

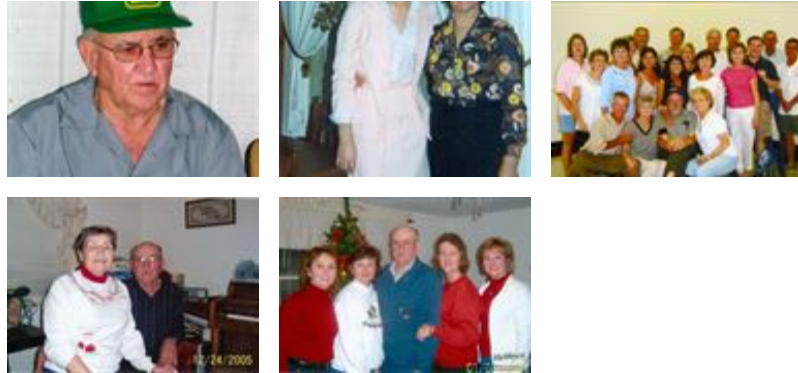
