Dale Uhl, a beloved husband, father, grandfather, and brother, passed away early Thursday morning, October 31st. surrounded by the people he cared about most, his family. Born in the Bronx, Dale was the son of Howard and Marie Uhl of Southampton, NY.

His first love was wrenching on and racing cars, especially his No. 18 modified car which he raced at the Riverhead Raceway. His skills as a diver earned him the respect of his colleagues, a respect which carried over to his life's work as a carpenter and general contractor for many people on the East End of Long Island. Unable to disappoint a customer, he ventured into Manhattan to renovate an apartment for one of his customers. Dale's integrity was beyond reproach and the quality of his workmanship will stand for decades. Self-educated, he left school early to support his family, and later would earn a certificate in Architectural Estimating from Pace University in his quest to further enrich his professional knowledge. He literally built his business, Dale

Uhl. Inc., and his home in Amagansett from the ground up. Along the way, he volunteered with the Amagansett Fire Department for fifteen years.

In his own quiet and unassuming way, Dale always watched out for his family, friends, and neighbors, quietly offering help and advice expecting nothing in return. In later years, Dale and Dona moved to Conway, South Carolina, where Dale continued to help his neighbors and local contractors build, despite being ???retired.???
