



Pastor Danny E. Martin

September 5, 1962 - May 1, 2014

Conway...Pastor Danny Earl Martin, age 51, entered the presence of his Lord and Savior Jesus Christ Thursday, May 1, 2014 after a battle with cancer.

Danny was born in Loris, a son of the late Edward Earl Martin and the late Clara Mae Gerald Martin. He was pastor of Grace Bible Church in Myrtle Beach and devoted his life to preaching the gospel of Jesus Christ. Danny spent 15 years at Calvary Christian School where he served as high school teacher, administrator and principal. His passions in life were reading, teaching, loving his family, and first of all serving his Lord and preaching the gospel. His life verse was Acts 20:24 "But none of these things move me, neither count I my life dear unto myself, so that I might finish my course with joy, and the ministry, which I have received of the Lord Jesus, to testify the gospel of the grace of God."

Survivors include his wife of 30 years, Terri Ulmer Martin; son, Adam Martin and his wife Jessica; daughter, Ashley Martin; grandchildren, Addison, Gabby Rose, and Jack all of Conway; brother, David Martin and his wife Robin; step-mother, Robin Martin; two step-sisters, Jan Cash and her husband Lanny, and Candace Hudson and her husband Jake all of Chesnee, SC; six nephews and eight nieces.

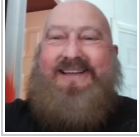

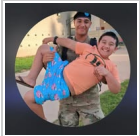

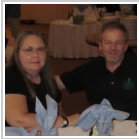
