David D. Alexander age 88, formerly of Watertown, CT passed away peacefully at his home surrounded by family on January 6, 2024, in Surfside Beach, SC.

He was born at Abington Memorial Hospital, PA on October 20, 1935, to Hayden D. and Emma B. (Walters) Alexander. He was married for 62 years to Dorothy A. (Peaker) Alexander.
