Reverend David George Black, age 74, died Friday, March 8, 2024 at MUSC Medical Center.

Born in Rives Junction, MI, David was a son of the late George and Florence Black. David served in the United States Army during the Vietnam War. He later retired from General Motors. David entered in to ministry in 2001. He was active in the Michigan district and South Carolina district of the Assemblies of God. He was, at different times, a Senior Pastor, a Sectional Presbyter, and served on staff of several different churches. David was a member of South Strand Assembly of God where he did Pastoral Care. Pastor Robert Hayes saw David as one of the finest men and most effective ministry partners with whom he has ever served. David was also a Chaplin for the Murrells Inlet VFW for a short time before his passing. David enjoyed spending his free time golfing or fishing and was a fan of football and baseball. David is preceded in death by his son, Lucas James Black.

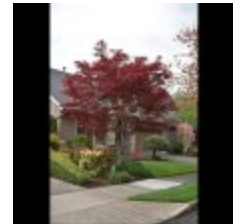
