



## David Bruffey Day

August 11, 1926 - September 2, 2016

Mr. David Day of Conway passed away suddenly following hip surgery, only 5 weeks after the death of his beloved wife Nancy.

David served in the Pacific with the U.S. Navy Amphibious Forces in WWII.

After the war, he studied architecture at Virginia Polytechnic Institute and eventually became a partner in the architectural firm of Smithey and Boynton in Roanoke, VA.

David was an avid fisherman and a talented (or he would humbly say, enthusiastic) watercolorist. He married Nancy Shumaker in 1948

and they lived in Roanoke, VA until 1996, at which point they moved to the Myrtle Beach area, the site of many happy family vacations over the years.

David is survived by son Jim, daughter-in-law Shari, and grandkids Jordan and Eric, all of whom will sorely miss their loveable Pop/GrandPop. David was

preceded in death by Nancy and by daughter Pam. Son, Roger, of Ft.

Lauderdale, FL, passed away only 2 weeks after David, on September 15 after a brief struggle with pancreatic cancer.

A memorial service for David will be held at Christ United Methodist Church, 2901 Fantasy Way, Myrtle Beach on Thursday, October 27 at 11 am, officiated by Rev. Jeff Dunn.
