David Blauvelt Jackson age 54 of Surfside Beach, died suddenly Tuesday, June 23, 2015 at Tideland's Waccamaw Community Hospital in Murrells Inlet.

Born in Ridgewood NJ, David became a resident of South Carolina in 2004. He was the former owner of Jackson's Car Wash and a graduate of Leadership Grand Strand. He also was a member of the Coast of Carolina Parrot Head Club. David was a member of the graduating class of 1980 at Tilton Academy in Tilton, NH and a graduate of Roger Williams College in 1983. After spending many years in the banking industry David changed careers and became a Hotel Operator in Sugarbush VT.
