November 9, 1972 - November 19, 2012

David Joseph Laine went to be with Jesus in Heaven, at 5:17 p.m. on November 19, 2012, and is free from the pain and suffering of cancer. David was born November 9, 1972, in New Orleans, LA. He enjoyed spending time with his friends, attending jazz fests and other festivals, enjoying New Orleans food, and listening to jazz in the French Quarter clubs. David's great-great uncle, Papa Jack Laine, was a New Orleans pioneering jazz band leader at the turn of the Twentieth Century. David collected books on poems, history, art, biographies. Downbeat magazine was a favorite to read of new artists, and he liked to give the subscription as gifts. He enjoyed gardening, photography, playing X-box games, soccer, and was a Who Dat Saints fan!

David attended St. Pius Elementary School and Brother Martin High School, in New Orleans; and St. Stanislaus High School in Bay St. Louis, MS.

During Hurricane Katrina in 2005, David and his friends did not evacuate, but did some good deeds, such as "borrowing" a boat to "make groceries" and deliver food and water to stranded people, who had not evacuated because they did not want to leave their pets behind. After a few days, David and his friends and others, were airlifted from Delgado Community College City Park campus, taken to Louis Armstrong Airport, and flown to a military base in Salt Lake City, UT, where he lived for five months. He eventually returned to New Orleans and worked in the aftermath cleanup for a few months.

After he moved to Pawleys Island, SC, in 2006, he had a job within a week with Blalock Plumbing in Socastee, where he worked for 3 years, and was voted Best Employee of the Year while there. [David was a hard worker and had an excellent work ethic, which he acquired while working for his father's company, Laine and Co. from the time he was 14 years old.]He decided to work closer to home, and became self-employed in plumbing and construction work for the various vacation homes, and condos in Litchfield, Pawleys Island, DeBordieu, and Georgetown properties.

David made many friends in Pawleys Island, in work and leisure time. He loved to load his bicycle onto his truck and drive to Huntington Beach State Park to ride and enjoy nature. Although a young person, David had an "old" soul and a wonderful sense of humor. His friends appreciated his thoughtfulness and kindness. If he said he would do something for you, you could depend on his word, and he would do anything for his friends. He will be missed by his friends.

David is survived by and is sorely missed by his mother, Jane Lane of Pawleys Island; and by his father, Chris Laine of Slidell, LA; his big brother Chris Laine, Jr.{Dana}, New Holland, PA; his big sister, Donna Laine Cannatella {Ron}Corpus Christi, TX; his uncle Talmadge Norman Lane, Jr. CA; his step-uncle Jim Summers{Bobbie} Cary, NC; and dear friends, Sunny and Tony Rivino of Georgetown, SC.

The family of David Laine send their deepest gratitude to MPPC Hope House for providing a place for David's mother to stay while David was hospitalized at MUSC NICU, Charleston. The family is very grateful to the nurses, staff, and doctors at MUSC and Georgetown Hospital for their care for David during his many stays.
