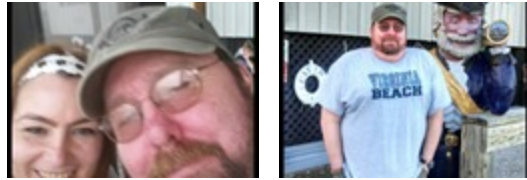
“ I remember Dave in high school he had a great voice with the chorus. I lost contact after high school, but sorry to hear of his passing.
