Mr. David Leroy Summers, 83, passed away Wednesday, January 31, 2018 at his home following an extended illness.

Born December 26, 1934, in Cameron, SC, David was the son of the late Samuel Jacob Summers, Jr. and the late Fair Snelson. Affectionately known as "Pop" to his family and friends, David spent over 40 years shaping his business, The Daisy Fair Flowers, into a successful household name. He was dedicated to serving Conway's blushing brides, grieving families, and his community with pride. His strong work ethic was always paired with a smile. He loved to travel the world, and his destination of choice would always be Key West. David also served his country in the United States Air Force during the Korean Conflict.
