Donald King, age 71, went to be with his Lord on Tuesday, September 1, 2020 with his family by his side.

Mr. King was born in Conway, a son of the late Allard and Esther King. He was easy going and very generous. Mr. King loved flowers and plants and was the owner of King's Florist for 36 years. He loved to cook for everyone. Mr. King proudly served his country in the Army National Guard for 20 years. He loved his grandchildren and they meant the world to him. He was generous of his time to help others. Mr. King was a past deacon and Sunday school teacher at North Conway Baptist Church. He had 30 years of civil service and was Florist of the Year for South Carolina Floral Association and a top 500 FTD Florist. In addition to his parents, he is predeceased by eleven siblings, Thurman King, Estelle King Lewis, Mazie King Brown, Allard King Jr., Harmon King, Sam King, Dorothy King Anderson, Howard King, Mildred King, Billy Joe King, and Jack King.

Survivors include his wife of 50 years, Mona S. King; two sons, Chris King (Jennifer) of Myrtle Beach, and Landon King (Jill) of Conway; grandchildren Gabby, Creed and Jackson; one sister, Mary King Tall; and one brother, Johnny Collins King; and many nieces, nephews, and friends.
