D.R. "Sonny" Langfitt, age 72 of Rimsdale Drive died Tuesday, September 27, 2005 at Mt. Carmel East in Columbus, OHIO. Born July 30, 1933 in Parkersburg, WV, he was the son of the late Donald Langfitt and Marie Stoops Hardesty. He was a graduate of Ohio University in Athen, OH. Mr. Langfitt was a US Army veteran stationed at Ft. Benning, Ga. and also in the US Army Reserve and the WV National Guard for fourteen years leaving at the rank of Captain. He served in high level financial positions with two Fortune 500 Companies. He retired in 1992 from A&S Building Systems, a metal building fabrication facility where he served as President and CEO. Mr. Langfitt was a member of Murrells Inlet American Legion Post #178, life member of Parkersburg Elks Lodge #198, A.F. & A.M., Mount Olivet Lodge #3, the Scottish Rite of Free Masonry, Nemesis Temple Shrine and Royal Order of Jesters Court #156 all of Parkersburg, WV. He was past president of the Board of the Parkersburg YMCA and of the Parkersburg Boys Club Foundation Board. Mr. Langfitt was preceded in death by his wife, Judy in 1998. Surviving are daughters and their husbands, Debra and Larry Eggers of Murrells Inlet, Becky and Don Tanner of Parkersburg, WV and Lori and John Boice of Canal Westchester, OH; granddaughter, Lindsey Eggers of Murrells Inlet; brother, Dudley Hardestey of Belpre, OH and sisters, Melissa Boatwright of Fairfax, VA and Jo Ellen Cutright and Athens, OH.
