Mr. Donald Vincent Slee, age 81, died Saturday August 30 at Grand Strand Regional Medical Center in Myrtle Beach.

Mr. Slee was born in August of 1933 in Phillipsburg, PA to the late Herschel and Geraldine (Hefferon) Slee and grew up in Altoona, PA where he was a member of St. Marks Catholic Church. He received a Bachelor's Degree in Arts from Park College, Kansas City, MO. After serving his country proudly in the U.S. Air Force from 1953-57, he continued to have a 37 year Civil Service career in Logistics spanning from Gentile Air Depot PA, Newark Air Force Station, Newark, Ohio, Hill Air Force Base, Utah, RAF Kemble, England to Robins Air Force Base, Georgia where he retired as an Senior Executive Officer for the C-130, F-15, C-5 Aircraft Division. He received the Air Force Logistics Command Distinguished Civilian Service Award for exceptional contributions to the AFLC mission. After retirement Mr. Slee was employed at Middle Georgia Technical College for 14 years holding various staff positions. Mr. Slee was a resident of Warner Robins/Perry GA from 1986-2011 and was a member of St. Patricks Catholic Church. Mr. Slee then moved to Murrells Inlet, SC in June 2011 with his wife to enjoy the coastal life.
