Dorethea Anne Long, 95, of Conway, SC., passed away Friday, April 7, 2023.

A Memorial service will be held at 11:00 am, Monday, April 17th at Maple Baptist Church.

Mrs. Long was born in Horry County, SC., a daughter of the late Hallie Porter and Emma Lewis Martin.

She graduated from Williamsburg High School as Valedictorian and later graduated from

Winthrop University. She received a master's degree in counseling from Western Carolina University

and attended Francis Marion University and University of South Carolina graduate classes to become a School Psychologist. She was employed with the Horry County Department of Education where she most recently served as a School Psychologist.

She was a faithful member of Maple Baptist Church and past Sunday school teacher. She loved sewing, quilting, and gardening.
