She was there when I was sick, she was there anytime I ever needed anything! I loved visiting her in myrtle beach too, I was over 20 when they moved there and into my 30's, I still felt like a little girl, being spoiled by my Nana. That's how she made me feel. Like the most loved, lucky, and important person in her life. I know she knows how special she was to me, I love her with all my heart. She will never be gone. She will be with me always.
