December 21, 1912 - September 17, 2015

Doris B. Shoebridge age 102, died Thursday, September 17, 2015 at her residence.

Doris was born in New York City on December 21, 1912, daughter of the late William and Laura Studer Burn. She moved from Staten Island, NY to the Jensen's Community in 1971. She became a member of Surfside United Methodist Church (SUMC) in 1972 and served on several committees. She represented the church in the founding of the Grand Strand Unit of Church Women United in 1985 and received the Valiant Women Award in 2005. Doris was past president of Surfside United Methodist Women and chosen as Outstanding SUMC Woman of the year in 2002. She most recently was chairman of the Reading Program. She was preceded in death by her beloved husband of 56 years, Walter A. Shoebridge and a brother, Edwin.

Survivors include her god-daughter, Karen Zencius; a number of nieces and her church family.

A memorial service will be held at 1:00 PM Thursday, September 24, 2015 at Surfside United Methodist Church with Reverend Laura Whitt officiating.
