Dorothy Fullwood Rabon, age 94, wife of the late Ona Eric Rabon, Sr., passed away Sunday, May 24, 2015 at Grand Strand Regional Medical Center.

Mrs. Rabon was born in Myrtle Beach, SC, a daughter of the late Charles Mack Fullwood, Sr. and Daisy Lee Turbeville Fullwood. In addition to her parents and husband she was preceded in death by her seven siblings.

Mrs. Rabon graduated from Socastee High School where she played on the first ladies basketball team. Prior to her retirement after 51 years, she was the longest tenured employee for AVX. She was a member of Sweetwater Branch Baptist Church in Conway. Mrs. Rabon is the last surviving member of her generation of both the Fullwood and Rabon family.
