



## Douglas David Williams

February 13, 1934 - April 25, 2025

Master Sergeant Douglas David Williams, born February 13, 1934, passed away at his home on Friday, April 25, 2025. He was the only son of Flora Culley, born in Evansville, Indiana.

He grew up in Chicago, Illinois where he enlisted into the United States Army at the age of 18. He spent 41.5 years serving his country defending our freedom with one tour in Korean and two tours in Vietnam as a paratrooper Special Forces, parachuting into battle zones with functions in infantry and direct action. He was awarded a Purple Heart and a Bronze Star for his heroism. He continued serving stateside at Fort Meade, Maryland working with the Military Police division, until his retirement.

Known by all as "Sarge", he continued to serve his community by being a volunteer for the City of Myrtle Beach, alongside his wife Doris Day, who preceded him in death.

He loved cruising and playing slots in the casino, as well as spending time with his daughter visiting new places.

He is survived by his daughter, Shari Brown of Myrtle Beach; Debbie Miller of Bowie, MD and Patti Swan of Hagerstown, MD as well as grandchildren and great-grandchildren along the East Coast.

The funeral service will be held at 11:00 AM Tuesday, April 29, 2025 at the Hillcrest Cemetery Indoor Chapel with full military honors.
