Rev. Dr. David H. Edwards, age 88, husband of Nancy Lou Edwards, passed away Tuesday, February 27, 2018.

Born October 12, 1929 in Philadelphia, PA, he was the son of the late Thomas W. and Madelline A. Baker Edwards. Rev. Edwards was a member of Socastee United Methodist Church in Myrtle Beach. He was a retired minister and a US Army Veteran of the Korean War. David worked for American Waterworks in NJ for over 40 years.
