



Dr. John "Jack" H. Albrecht, Jr.

Conway...Dr. John "Jack" H. Albrecht, Jr., age 63, of Ninth Avenue, Conway, died suddenly Tuesday, July 24, 2007 at his residence. Dr. Albrecht was born April 11, 1944 in Blackwood, NJ, a son of the late John Henry Albrecht, Sr. and Mary Anna Spencer Albrecht. He graduated from Williamstown High School in 1963. Dr. Albrecht continued his education graduating from Rutgers University with a B.A. in Humanities, and received his Masters Degree in Public Relations from Glassboro State College. In 1980, he graduated Magna Cum Laude from Sherman College of Straight Chiropractic in Spartanburg, SC where he also served as Dean of Student Services and Dean of Health Services. He served for his country in the U.S. Army, 11th Cavalry in Vietnam, 1967-1968. Dr. Albrecht worked in the Chiropractic field for 27 years, and owned and operated Albrecht Chiropractic in Conway since 1993. He was a long time member of First Presbyterian Church in Myrtle Beach where he sang with the Chancel Choir, taught the Adult Bible Study, and Qigong Classes. Dr. Albrecht and his wife traveled to Piedras Negros, Mexico as part of the Constructores Para Cristo Missionary Team with First Presbyterian Church. He was a member of the Palmetto State Chiropractic Association, Conway Kiwanis Club, and Rutgers Alumni Association of South Carolina. Dr. Albrecht was a lifelong learner holding a black belt in Isshinryu Karate, was an avid cyclist, sailor, runner and tennis player. He was passionate about music, especially classic and jazz, enjoyed playing the guitar, and worked with the Main Street USA Rivertown Jazz Festival every spring. Dr. Albrecht was

predeceased by a nephew, Edward Rhubart, Jr. Dr. Albrecht is survived by his wife of 34 years, Linda Ruth Sharrard Albrecht; two sons, John Albrecht and wife Laura of Elgin, SC and Joshua Albrecht and wife Keri of Myrtle Beach, SC; one daughter, Jennifer Albrecht of Baltimore, MD; one sister, Mary Rhubart and husband Edward of Turnersville, NJ; two nieces, Linda Phillips and husband Dr. David Phillips and Wendy Carlson of Turnersville, NJ; a number of great and great-great nieces and nephews. A memorial service will be held at 10:00 AM Saturday, July 28, 2007 from First Presbyterian Church of Myrtle Beach with the Dr. Robert Wilkes officiating.
