Edith Carriebell Haselden Graham, age 99, wife of the late J. Dawson Graham, Sr., passed away Wednesday, December 10, 2014, at her residence. Mrs. Graham was born in Goldsboro, NC. She was the daughter of the late Henry Ebenezer and Claudia Theodora Stalvey Haselden.

Mrs. Graham was a member of The Refuge @ FPHC for 63 years. She also worked with the Horry County School District. Mrs. Graham was talented as a late-blooming artist. She also enjoyed her children, gardening, and arts and crafts.
