He attended Sewanee Military Academy, Georgia Tech University and The University of the South Sewanee. Mr. Apperson served honorably in World War II on a PT Boat in the US Navy. Following his discharge he pursued the cotton business and a successful Real Estate career, being instrumental in the development of the McAlistar Square Mall and the Myrtle Square Mall. He loved the Greenville Little Theater, participating in many performances, most notably as Eliza Doolittles father in "My Fair Lady" for which he won an Oscar. Surviving are his wife: Jo Ann K. Apperson; two sons: Edmund M. Apperson, IV and wife, Tiffany of Philadelphia, Pa.; and Scott Daniel and wife, Beth of Greenville, SC.; two daughters: Millie Apperson of Greenville, SC. and Kim Ford and husband, John of Goldsboro, NC; 7 grandchildren and a brother: George Patterson Apperson, Jr. and wife, Frances of Greenville, SC.
