



## Edna Patterson

June 17, 1923 - December 23, 2012

Edna Marie Foxworth Patterson, 89 was reunited with family and friends as she was called home to glory on Sunday, December 23, 2012. Born in Andrews, SC in 1923 and moved to what would later become Myrtle Beach at four years of age with her parents and her siblings in 1927. Edna attended Myrtle Beach schools and graduated from Myrtle Beach High School.

During the war she met Harry K. "Pat" Patterson, serving in the US Army Air Corp and stationed at the Myrtle Beach Army Air Field. Pat and Edna fell in love and were married at the First Baptist Church of Myrtle Beach. Though Pat was from Massachusetts, the couple settled here.

Beginning in the early fifties, Edna and Pat were early pioneers of the hotel business in Myrtle Beach where they owned and operated The Patterson Motel.

Pat and Edna Patterson remained members of the First Baptist Church of Myrtle Beach with Pat serving as a deacon. After seeing the growth near their retirement home near the waterway, The Patterson began organizational efforts and eventually helped found and were charter members of Forestbrook Baptist Church. Both remained devoted members.

Edna Patterson was predeceased by her parents, Marion Dargan Foxworth, Sr. and Beulah Marie Garner Foxworth; two sisters, Annie Foxworth and Ruby Foxworth Brooks; two brothers, L.S. Foxworth and Marion Dargan Foxworth, Jr. and her husband, Harry K. "Pat" Patterson. Edna is survived by her daughter, Connie Patterson Coe and her son in law, Tom Coe; two

grandchildren, Melanie Wiggins and Randall Wiggins; two nieces; one nephew and several other loving extended family members.

Services will be 11:00 AM, Thursday, December 27, 2012 at Forestbrook Baptist Church with Rev. Wayne Revisky officiating. The family will receive friends one hour prior at the church.
