In 1989 he and his wife moved to South Carolina though retired remained active in the investment business. He was predeceased by a brother, Ernst Bischoff Kemm. He is survived by his wife, Gail G. Kemm; a son, Edward Kemm Jr., a grandson, Edward Scott Kemm; a brother, Karl T. Kemm; and pets, Dusty and Snow.
