Edward Michael Cavanaugh, 84 of Indian Wells died Thursday, October 25, 2012 at Waccamaw Community Hospital.

Born in Philadelphia, PA, he was the son of the late James and Regina Cavanaugh. Mr. Cavanaugh was a US Navy veteran. He had retired in 1989 from Philadelphia Electric Co. after 35 years of service. An avid golfer, he founded the "Stop and Smell the Roses" group in 1958 and it continues to this day. He retired to the area in 1991 moving from Ridley Park, PA. Mr. Cavanaugh was a member of the Moose Lodge, American Legion and the VFW. His wife of 51 years, Doris, his son, Patrick, his grandson, Scott M. McQuade and his sisters, Helen Gasparro and Jean Seagraves all preceded him in death.

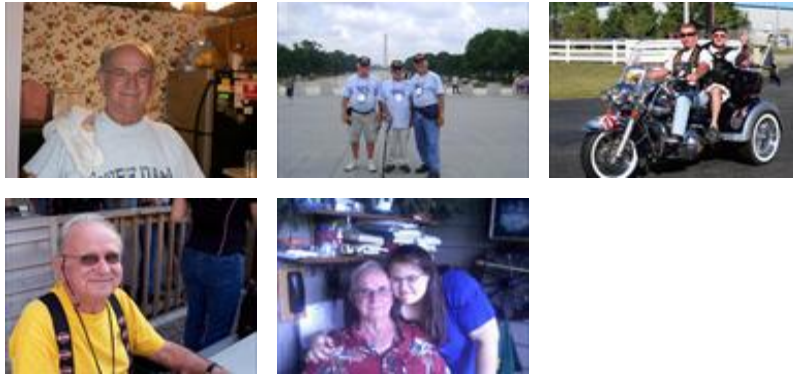
