Edward C. Radin, Jr., age 89, died Saturday, December 29, 2007 at Tideland's Community Hospice House. Mr. Radin was born in Brooklyn, NY a son of the late Edward Sr. and Mary Radin. He was a photoengraver with the American Bank Note Co. from 1968 to 1983 with prior employment with Art-Color Printing Co. in Dunellen, NJ. He was a US Army WWII veteran, Combat Infantry Badge recipient and was awarded the Bronze Star for service in the European Campaign. He was the recipient of the Combat Infantry Award and the Bronze Star. Mr. Radin was a member of the VFW Post 10420 in Murrells Inlet and a member of St. Michael Catholic Church. Mr. Radin was also a Eucharist Minister at St. John Evangelist Church in Saugerties, NY. Survivors include his wife, Marie C. Radin; three sons, Edward C. Radin III of NY, M.G. Robert M. Radin of IL, James A. Radin of MD; daughter, Maribeth Radin-MacKenzie of Myrtle Beach; four grandchildren, Elizabeth Fino-Radin of NY, Benjamin Fino-Radin of RI, Kathryn Anne Radin of MD, and Jack Brian Radin of MD.
