Edward James Coddington, age 84, passed away Tuesday, August 6, 2019 at his home with his family by his side.

Mr. Coddington was born in Susquehanna, PA, a son of the late Edward Patrick and Veronica Mary Coddington. Edward was a loving husband, father, grandfather, and great-grandfather and his family was very important to him. He was known for his sense of humor and corny jokes.
