



## Edward "Ed" Robert Meister

January 2, 1958 - October 14, 2023

Edward "Ed" Robert Meister, 65, of Myrtle Beach, passed away unexpectedly on Saturday, October 14, 2023, at Conway Medical Center in Conway, South Carolina. Ed was born January 2, 1958, in Audubon, New Jersey, a son of the late Edward A. Meister and Janet Green Meister. In addition to his parents, Ed was preceded in death by his brother, Jeffrey Meister.

Edward was raised in Titusville, New Jersey. He attended local schools and graduated from Hopewell Valley Central High School in 1976. He lived in Hamilton, New Jersey for over 20 years. During his working years, he was a delivery driver for UPS until he retired in October of 2018. After retiring from UPS, he and his family relocated to Myrtle Beach, South Carolina, where he worked part-time for Blackmoor Golf Club and later Myrtle Beach National Golf Club.

He loved running and biking in Triathlons, playing soccer and softball, and especially golfing, which he loved sharing with his sons and many close friends and family. Defazio of Three Bridges, NJ; his son Lyle E. 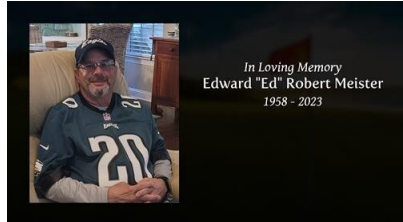
