Edward James Bjorness Murrells Inlet Edward James Bjorness age 76, died Sunday, December 7, 2008 at his residence. Mr. Bjorness was born in Brooklyn, NY a son of the late William and Janet Bjorness. He served in the U.S. Army from 1952-1954 and did Duty in Korea. Ed played pro hockey for teams in New York, Lake Placid, Utica, NY, Quebec and Ottawa, Canada. In 1955 he played for New Haven in the U.S. Senior Open Champions. In 1992 Ed's Ottawa Rockets Team was inducted into the Hockey Hall of Fame. He also served as a National Hockey League Official and Goal Judge from 1972-1990. Before retiring in 1988 he worked as an Engineer and Manager for 33 years for New York Telephone. Ed was a lifetime Member of the Masonic Lodge #368 and V.F.W. Post 10420 both in Murrells Inlet and Pratt Institute of Technology Alumni Association. Survivors include his wife Jeannie of Spring Forest; a son, William Bjorness and his wife Heidi of Oneonta, NY; three daughters, Dorothy Long and husband Eric of Myrtle Beach, Barbara Tyburczy and husband Gary of Linden, NJ and Patricia Gallagher and husband Rodney of Lynchburg, VA; seven grandchildren, Jessica Long, Alexei Tyburczy, Baker, Madison and Mason Gallagher, Adam and Addison Bjorness; six step-children, including Drs.
