



Edward William Kunz

April 9, 1946 - March 13, 2024

Mr. Edward “Ed” Willam Kunz, age 77, passed away in Charleston, South Carolina, on Wednesday, March 13, 2024.

Born August 9, 1946, in Hoboken, New Jersey, he was the son of the late Andrew William Frank Kunz and the late Marie Anne Kunz. Known as “Chip” growing up, Ed volunteered in 1968 to serve in the U.S. Army to fight in the Vietnam War. He served two tours during the war, his first as a lieutenant in the 101st Airborne Division and a second tour as a Captain in the Fifth Special Forces as a Green Beret. Following his honorable discharge, Ed was an East Rutherford firefighter, an East Rutherford Ordinance Enforcer, and an electrician with the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers. He moved his family to Pawleys Island in 1995 to become a restaurant proprietor, and was a consummate dreamer and a loving and fierce protector of his family. As proud of his service to his country as his family and friends were, HIS biggest pride and joy was his family. He and his wife, (Maureen) had four children: Tracy MacGeorge (Dave), Taryn Bruinooge (Dave), Andy Kunz (Rachel), and Carly Kunz. He is also survived by three grandsons: Liam Bruinooge, Henry Kunz, Jack Kunz and several loving nieces and nephews. Nothing made Ed happier than seeing his family and watching his grandsons grow.

In addition to his parents, Ed was predeceased by his loving older sister, Nancy Bowers.

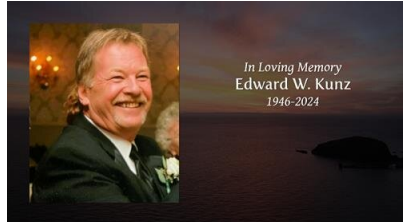
