Edward L. Keim, MD, age 84, died November 3, 2004 in Murrells Inlet, SC. Born May, 18, 1920 in Johnstown, PA he was the son of the late William L. Keim, MD and Martha Boyts Keim. Dr. Keim was predeceased by one brother, William W. Keim, Jr.. He was married 59 years to Betty Berkstresser Keim, who died May 7, 2003. Dr. and Mrs. Keim had three daughters, two sons-in-law and one grandson.: Martha Keim- St. Louis and Dana St. Louis, Franklinton, NC; Katherine Keim, State College, PA; Barbara Keim and Gregory May and Aaron May, North Canton, OH. His education included public schools in Davidsville, PA a BS from the University of Pittsburgh, as well as a MD from the University of Pittsburgh. He performed his internship and his residency at Memorial Hospital, Johnstown, PA. He was a general practitioner with his own practice for 17 years, a plant surgeon for Bethlehem Steel in Johnstown, PA, an emergency room physician and, for the last ten years of his career, a physician at Penn State University, retiring in 1984. He served in the US Army Medical Corps during WWII, honorably discharged as a captain. Dr. Keim was a past member of the American Medical Association, the Pennsylvania Medical Society, Memorial Hospital Staff president 1964, Cambria Lodge #278 F&A Masons, Jaffa Shrine, and the Elks BPOE.
