She attended Winthrop College and taught school briefly. Later she worked as a buyer for Belk. Mrs. Onley was a member of First Baptist Church of Conway for over 60 years where she sang in the choir and taught Sunday School. She has played an active role in her community. Some of her honors include Past Worthy Matron of Eastern Star, past president of Iris Garden Club, and past president of the Conway Garden Club Council, former Superintendent of the Young People's Department of the First Baptist Church. Mrs. Onley was president of the Conway Hospital Auxiliary for two terms with an accumulation of eleven thousand plus volunteer hours. Mrs. Onley also serves as a volunteer Chaplain and works with Mended Hearts. In 1994 she received recognition as the individual raising the most money for the Heart Association Walk-a-thon. She assists each year with the Conway Hospital Foundation's Kingston Golf Classic. Mrs. Onley is noted in her neighborhood for always lending a helping hand. Her other hobbies are bridge and dancing. Surviving are: one son, Ben Onley and wife Margaret of Pawleys Island; one daughter, Rita Beckham and husband George of Columbia; four grandchildren, Judith Buzzell, Deborah Staley and husband Phil, Ricky Beckham and wife Kristen and Tina Samellas and husband George; seven great-grandchildren.
