Ella Gabrell Powell Eaddy passed away at NHC Healthcare on Sunday, January 9, 2022. She was 100 years old.

Born March 8, 1921 in Hemingway, SC, she was the daughter of Clara Hughes and Eddie Powell. She was a loving mother and grandmother who enjoyed spending time with her family. She loved preparing Sunday dinner for her family every week. She enjoyed working in her yard, growing beautiful flowers and grew a very successful vegetable garden every season. She was instrumental in the development of Belin Creative Learning Center, becoming the first full-time director and remaining that for many years.
