She organized and participated in outreach projects from soup kitchens to quilting. She was a valued lab technician in the medical practices of Drs. Emmett and Arthur Madden for many years. Beth was remarkable in her faith and her interest in life and serving others. She spoke knowledgeably on many topics from politics to Atlanta Braves Baseball. She was an avid crossword puzzler. Because of her love of children, particularly her many nieces and nephews, she was affectionately known across several generations as Aunt Beth. Her smile, her love, her acts of faith will be greatly missed, but we know she is HOME.
