Garden City Beach Ellen Bartolomei Siegmund Ellen left us on February 5th, 2010 after a difficult and courageous battle with Alzheimer's; she was 88 years young. Miss Ellen was a long time resident of Jensen's retirement community in Garden City Beach before becoming a member of the family at Myrtle Beach Estates. Her husband, Warren Siegmund, Sr., preceded her in death in November, 1992. Miss Ellen was a member of the American Legion Post Number 178 in Murrells Inlet. She graduated from the Memorial Hospital School of Nursing and Northeastern University Medical School prior to enlisting in the U. S. Army. Miss Ellen served aboard the hospital ship USS Hope as a First Lieutenant in the South Pacific during World War II. Later she became School Nurse/Practitioner for the town of Gainesville, GA and retired as Head Nurse/Practitioner at a state hospital for special needs people. Miss Ellen was also the world's greatest Atlanta Braves fan, even during the bad years. Miss Ellen leaves a son, Warren Siegmund and his wife, Diane of Murrells Inlet, SC; a son, William Siegmund and his wife, Beverly of Oklahoma City, OK; and a daughter, Beverly Sherwood and her husband, Bill of Southbridge, MA. Her daughter, Linda Sue Siegmund of Surfside Beach, lost her battle with cancer in November, 1998. She is also survived by 7 grandchildren and 11 great grandchildren. Miss Ellen will be buried at the National Cemetery on Cape Cod beside her beloved husband. A private memorial service will be held for family members at the National Cemetery in the near future.
