



## Elma Collins

June 23, 1925 - December 3, 2014

Conway...Elma Herring Collins passed away on Wednesday, December 3rd, at the home she shared with her daughter and son-in-law, following several years of declining health. Mrs. Collins, daughter of Tolar and Minnie Williams Herring, born on June 23, 1925, in Horry County. She attended Conway High School and married her sweetheart, Hampton Lindsay Collins, on June 10, 1943. After the end of World War II, they returned to the Tilly Swamp community in Horry County, where they enjoyed almost 55 years together, until Lindsay's passing in April, 1998. They worked the family farm hand-in-hand and raised their family in the Collins family home where Lindsay had been born and reared. Their lives centered around their Church, their family and many friends. In their later years they spent many happy days with Lloyd and Marvalee, Alleene, Kat and Mildine, and the many friends they made at Oceans Lakes Campground.

In addition to her parents and husband, Mrs. Collins was predeceased by her beloved son Michael Kent ("Mickey") Collins, grandson Robert Lindsay ("Bob") Collins; brothers, T.W. Herring, a Marine who died on Iwo Jima in 1945, and Anson Herring of Charleston; sisters, Alleene H. Vaught, Kathleen H. Reaves and Marvalee H. Parker and her husband Lloyd, who was like a brother to Mrs. Collins.
